# Speaker at the conference

## Johan Roos

Professor and Executive Advisor at HULT International Business School, Senior Advisor to the Global Peter Drucker Forum, portfolio entrepreneur, and member of the Danish Academy of Technical Sciences.

Previously Chief Academic Officer at HULT (London, Boston, San Francisco, Dubai); Managing Director, Dean and Professor at Jönköping International Business School; President at Copenhagen Business School; Dean of MBA Programs and SCA Professor at Stockholm School of Economics; Director of Imagination Lab Foundation; Professor at IMD; Associate Professor at Norwegian Business School; and Post-Doc Researcher at Wharton School.

His research concerns mostly how to increase readiness for change, innovate strategy processes, and measuring intellectual capital. Since the inception of Generative AI, his research has focused on the impact of AI on leadership and how professionals create value in an era of algorithms. Dr. Roos regularly contributes to the public debate about management innovation, business education and the impact of AI. He currently serves as a commissioned thought leader for the largest accreditation and quality control organization in the business school sector.

He is the originator of the idea, co-developer of the prototypes, and co-inventor of the LEGO® SERIOUS PLAY® method and has chaired this conference since its inception. In 2026, Routledge published his book *Human Magic: Leading with Wisdom in a World of Algorithms*.

## Alison James

Alison James is a UK National Teaching Fellow (2014), Principal Fellow of the HEA and Professor Emerita at the University of Winchester. Across a long university career, she has held multiple managerial and academic roles at different levels and across disciplines. Her work consistently explores alternative, playful and creative approaches to adult learning.

She has a lifelong interest in identity and self-construction—what shapes people, how they see themselves, and how they find their path. She believes that “we do not see the world as it is, we see it as we are” (attributed to Anaïs Nin). This perspective informed her MA and PhD, her work as a qualified coach (Institute of Leadership and Management), and her extensive teaching in personal and professional development (PPD).

Alison is widely published on play and creativity and their intersections with fields such as PPD. Her book *Engaging Imagination* (with Stephen Brookfield, Jossey-Bass, 2014) supports creative and reflective thinking. With Chrissi Nerantzi, she has co-authored several works on play, including *The Power of Play in HE* (2019), downloaded over 80,000 times globally.

More recently, she led a three-year study, *The Value of Play in HE* (2022), supported by the Imagination Lab Foundation, followed by PLAYI (2025), exploring play and generative AI in higher education. Both are freely available via her website.

An experienced LEGO® SERIOUS PLAY® facilitator since 2010, Alison has been part of the Inthrace family since 2019. She co-authored LSP in HE with Micael Buckle and co-delivers this intensive online course with Marc Sonnaert.
